Mother's Day Around the World

In many households, the second Sunday in May begins with breakfast in bed, a bouquet of flowers, homemade cards, and other tokens of affection for mom. In other corners of the globe, honoring Mom is a rite grounded in local traditions and customs.

India: 10-Day Festival
Each October, Hindus honor
Durga, the goddess of mothers,
during the 10-day festival known
as Durga Puja. The celebration is
thought to date back to the
sixteenth century and is
considered both a religious
ceremony and a time for family

reunions. Families spend weeks preparing food, gathering gifts, and decorating their homes for the festival.

Japan: The Right Flowers
Following World War II, a
version of Mother's Day grew
popular as a way of comforting
mothers who had lost sons to the
war. You'll see carnations
presented around this March
holiday, as they symbolize the
sweetness and endurance of
motherhood in Japanese culture.
Originally, children gave a red
carnation to a living mother and
displayed a white one if their
mother had died. Now, white

has become the traditional color.

Ethiopia: Sing Along!

The Antrosht festival, observed at the end of the rainy season in early fall, is dedicated to moms. After the weather clears for good, family members from all over flock to their homes for a large meal and celebration. Daughters traditionally bring vegetables and cheese, while sons supply the meat. Together, they prepare a meat hash and sing and perform dances that tell stories of family heroes.



Ages & Stages Questionnaires (ASQ®)

Everyone should have recently received an email and a link to complete an ASQ® Screening for their child (ren). If you did not receive one, or would prefer to complete the ASQ® on paper, please

let the office know and we will send one to you.

Once you complete the ASQ® you will receive a comprehensive recap outlining your child's strengths, along with some activities that you

can do at home with your child(ren) to build their skills.

There are no special tools or toys needed to complete the questionnaire and it is free for all agency families and members.

If you have any questions about the process, please connect with us, we are happy to answer your questions.

Areas on ASQ3

The ASQ®-3 screens five key areas of development in young children to create a well-rounded snapshot of the child's skills and abilities.

This handout lists the areas of development and briefly explains each.

Communication

Assesses language, both what a child understands and how they follow directions (receptive) and how they vocalize, use words, and start to make sentences (expressive).

Gross Motor

Assesses large muscle (body, arms, and legs) movement and coordination.

Fine Motor

Assesses eye/hand and hand/ finger movements and coordination, pre-writing skills.

Problem Solving

Assesses skills of thinking and learning, how child solves problems, pre-academic skills.

Personal-Social

Assesses **self-help** skills (e.g., feeding, dressing, toileting) and **social interactions** with others.

COVID Support Funding

Late fall 2020, a series of funding announcements were made in support of child care programs across the province (consisting of provincial and federal dollars). Each program was able to determine how best to utilize the funds received.

Our Advisory Board determined that the best use of the money would be to support families faced with having to stay home due to COVID illness requirements for quarantine and testing—either their own illness or their child's.

The agency credited families back for the days out of care while in quarantine or awaiting testing results, and still paid the educators on behalf of the families.

This was done to support families and to reduce some of the financial stresses of having to stay home due to the COVID health restrictions, and to ensure a stable income for the day home educators.

To date \$11,000.00 has been credited back to families in our program.
